- Bidding on silent auction items will take place between 6:00 pm and 9:15 pm
- Bidding on live auction items will take place between approx. 8:45 pm and 9:15 pm
- Anyone may bid on as many items as they wish.
- Bid sheets are displayed near each silent auction item. Print your contact info legibly on the first available blank line. Please remember to read the descriptions carefully.
- The first bid must be at least the minimum. Please use round dollar amounts.
- To raise the bid, it must be at least the minimum increment on the bid sheet. Please use round dollar amounts.
- Be sure that your bid is always the highest. Write new bids on the next available line. If the bed sheet fills up, additional sheets will be provided by volunteers. Do not write on the back of bid sheets.
- All silent auction bids will close at 9:15 pm sharp. Please make sure your final bids are made by then.
- The silent auction item winners will be announced directly after the live auction.
- Payment for your items may be made at the Auction Checkout Table, located in the hallway, near the stairs and the registration table. Payment may be made by cash (exact change please), check, or credit card (MasterCard, Visa, Discover or American Express). We will have a credit card swiper on hand.
- Payment in full is required before you may receive your items.
- Be sure to check the end of this catalog for the fine print.
